


ART GUILD DAY TRIP

Runnymede Sculpture Farm and a South Bay Collection

8:30 am to 4:30 pm


We are excited to be offering a trip to The South Bay with a visit to the splendid Atherton home and collection of **Susan and Joel Hyatt**. This is a wonderful, eclectic collection that runs the gamut from works by such luminaries as Warhol, Picasso, Calder and Miró to marvelous local art fair finds.

We will then head to Woodside for a box lunch at **Runnymede Sculpture Farm**.

Runnymede has approximately 140 pieces of sculpture on its 100 acres. While the majority of the artists are from the U.S., others are from Spain, England, Italy, Germany and France. Only contemporary living artists were installed. Artist Sol LeWitt created the first piece in 1969. Robert Arneson, Stephen De Staebler, Mark di Suvero, Viola Frey, Jun Kaneko, Charles Ginnever and Andy Goldsworthy are among the multitudinous artists exhibited.

Phil Linhares has graciously agreed to join us for the day. We will self-guide around the property for approximately two hours. The terrain can be very challenging, with elevation gains on gravel and dirt paths, not appropriate for casual walkers. Wear hiking boots or good walking shoes. A hat, sunscreen, a way to carry water and hiking poles are suggested.

This is a rare opportunity to visit Runnymede, which is not open to the public, and which may not be available for visitation in the future.
