PLANNING YOUR VISIT

Parking

Public parking is available nearby. Please be advised that street parking will be limited.

Metered parking is available in the Kaiser parking lot off 10th Street. Free after 6 p.m. and all day Sunday.

Alco Parking Garage will be open at 12th and Jackson streets, Saturday 8 a.m. to 10 p.m.; Sunday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. (fee required)

Public Transit

We encourage you to take public transportation. OMCA is one block from the Lake Merritt BART station and accessible on AC Transit. Please visit bart.gov, actransit.org, or 511.org for more information.
