


## **COLORING AND CONVERSATION GUIDE**



What types of clothes, fabrics, or patterns show who you are, your culture, or tell your story? In the empty box, draw a piece of clothing or pattern that is special to you.








Many of Chelsea Ryoko Wong's paintings show cultural traditions, like playing *mahjong* or eating Chinese *dim sum* with family and friends.
