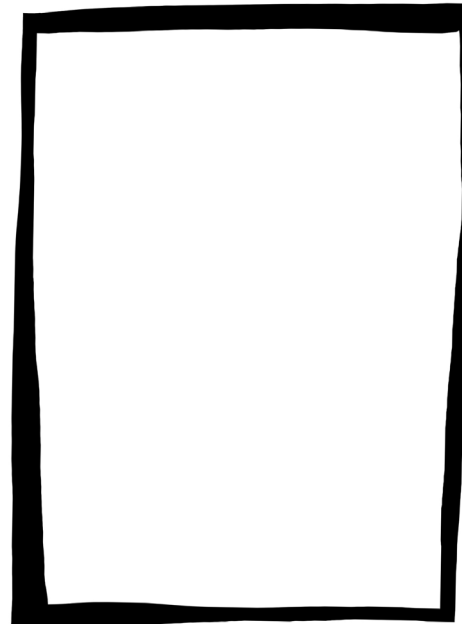
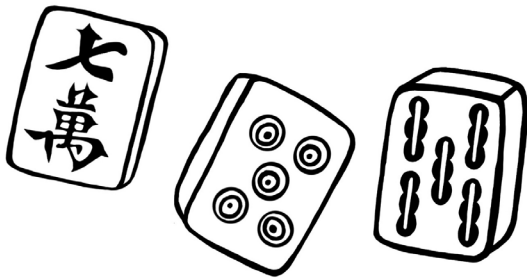
## COLORING AND CONVERSATION GUIDE

What types of clothes, fabrics, or patterns show who you are, your culture, or tell your story?

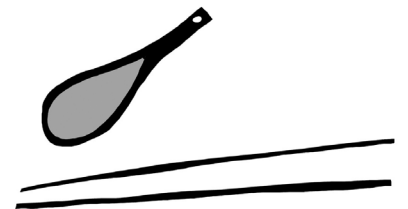
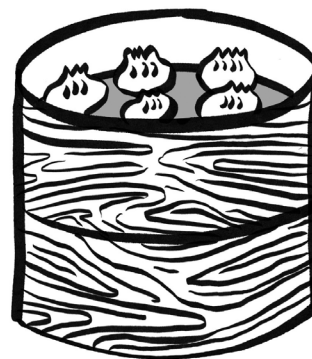
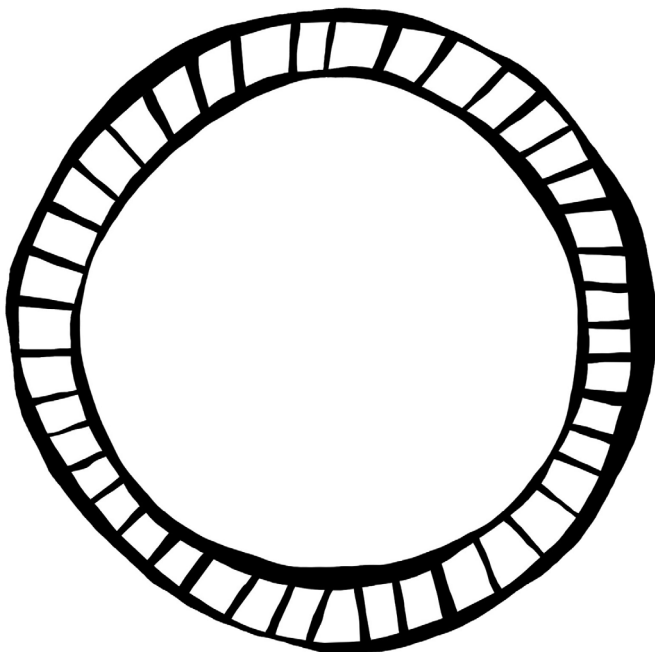
**In the empty box, draw a piece of clothing or pattern that is special to you.**
